## "I Spy" Window Bean Bag

- cut 1 piece of fabric 6 1/2" x 7 1/2"
- cut 1 strip of fabric 3" by approximately 20"
- cut 1 heavy plastic window 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" by 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"
- 1 Cup plastic bead stuffing
- assorted "I Spy" items
- \*\* 1/2" seam allowance used on all seams
- \*\* sew with plastic next to feed dogs
- 1) Sew a 3" fabric strip to the 2 opposite long sides (3 ½") of the plastic window. Cut the fabric strip even with the plastic. Top Stitch these 2 seams approximately ¼" laying the seam allowance away from the plastic window.
- 2) Sew a 3" fabric strip across the other 2 sides of the plastic window, including the strips previously sewn. Cut even with the first strips sewn and Top Stitch.
- 3) With right sides together match the window unit to the 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" piece of fabric. Sew a 1/2" seam around 3 sides leaving one short side open. Sew a second line approximately 1/4" inside the seam allowance to reinforce (or serge this raw edge).
- 4) Press under ½" on the opening raw edge. Fill bag with 1 cup of plastic beads. Place your "I Spy" items in the bag. Sew a double row of Top Stitching to close the bean bag.
- 5) Have *FUN* with your "I Spy" Bean Bag.
